

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH – PROFESSOR W GLENN MCCLUGGAGE

I am a consultant Histopathologist in Belfast Health and Social Care Trust, Belfast and an Honorary Professor in Gynaecological Pathology of Queen's University of Belfast. I have published approximately 650 papers in peer reviewed journals, including original publications and many invited editorials and reviews. I am on the Editorial Board of several major pathology journals (Modern Pathology, Human Pathology, Advances in Anatomic Pathology, International Journal of Gynecological Pathology, Virchows Archives), a member of the International Advisory Board of Journal of Clinical Pathology and associate editor of Histopathology. I am past President of International Society of Gynecological Pathologists and was previously secretary of this society. Previously I was President of the British Association of Gynaecological Pathologists. I have an extremely busy referral practice and receive numerous consultation cases from all over the world. I have been invited to lecture at numerous national and international meetings. I have authored or coauthored the various Royal College of Pathologists datasets in United Kingdom on reporting of gynaecological malignancies and have chaired the ICCR (International Collaboration on Cancer Reporting) panels developing international guidelines for reporting endometrial, ovarian, cervical, vulval and vaginal carcinomas. I am also the ICCR series champion for gynaecological neoplasms. I have been part of the last three World Health Organization (WHO) groups formulating the classification of Tumours of the Female Genital Tract and am one of the editors on the latest 2020 WHO Classification.
