

Wolfgang Weber, MD is Professor and Chair of the Department of Nuclear Medicine at the Technical University of Munich in Germany (TUM). Dr. Weber's research is focused on molecular imaging of cancer for planning and monitoring of therapeutic interventions. He is also interested in targeted radionuclide therapy of cancer and theranostics.

Dr. Weber was trained in Nuclear Medicine at the Technical University of Munich from 1993 to 1998 and worked there as an attending physician. In 2003, he moved to the US as an Associate Professor at the Department of Molecular and Medical Pharmacology at UCLA. He returned to Germany in 2007 as a full professor and chair of the department of Nuclear Medicine at the University of Freiburg.

In 2013 Dr. Weber was recruited to Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center New York to lead the Molecular Imaging and Therapy Service. He returned to Munich in 2018.
